This email serves to update trainers and providers on changes that have been made in the DSS 32-hour Medication Management curriculum that was previously under contract with the Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) Department of Gerontology.

Effective July 1, 2024, VCU will no longer manage the 32-hour Medication Management training. The following changes are effective July 1, 2024, for trainers of the 32-hour Medication Management curriculum.

- Trainers who currently offer the 32-hour Medication Management class are expected to issue their own certificates or provide documentation of completed training. DSS will not issue certificates.
- Trainers of the DSS 32-hour Medication Management class do not need to register or obtain approval to teach the curriculum however they are expected to meet the requirements of 18VAC90-21-20, Qualifications of Instructional Personnel in the Virginia Board of Nursing Regulations for Training Programs for Medication Administration by Unlicensed Persons and Immunization Protocol.
- A train-the-trainer program is no longer needed for new trainers.
- A previous list of trainers for the 32-hour Medication Management class is available upon written request to Marina Sinyard, nurse consultant at Marina.sinvard@dss.virginia.gov. No new trainers will be added to this list.

- Providers do not need to use a trainer on the list but must comply with applicable regulatory authority requirements.
- The approved BON 32-hour Medication Management for Persons Authorized under the Drug Control Act curriculum is available upon request to Marina Sinyard, nurse consultant at Marina.sinyard@dss.virginia.gov.
